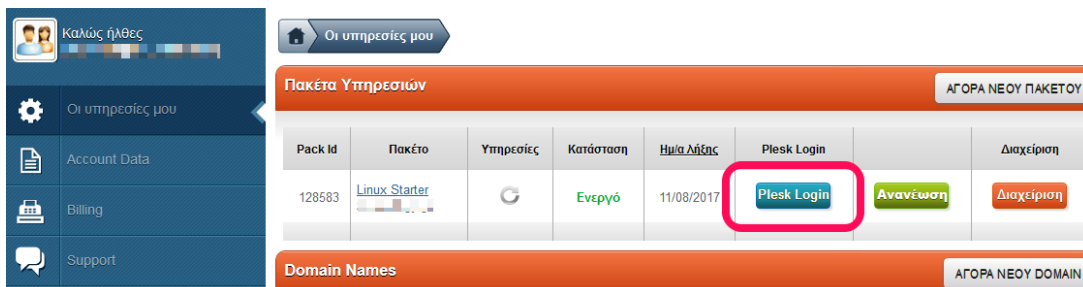
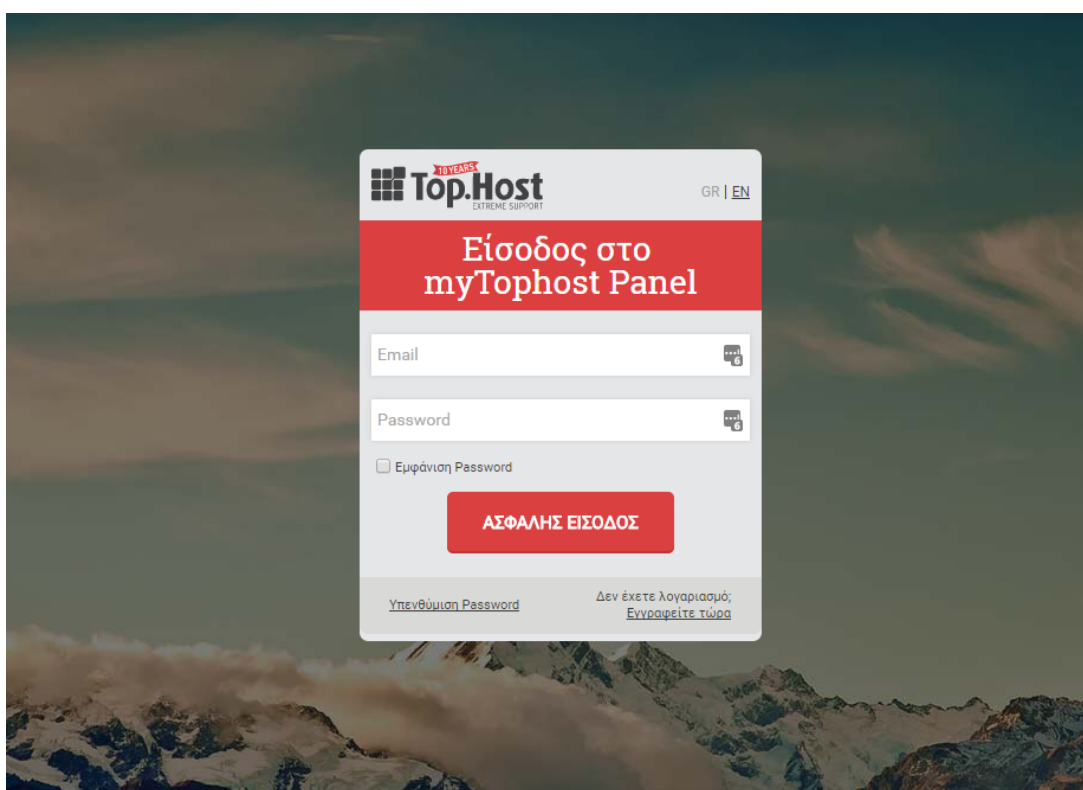


## Can I have an email account for a subdomain?

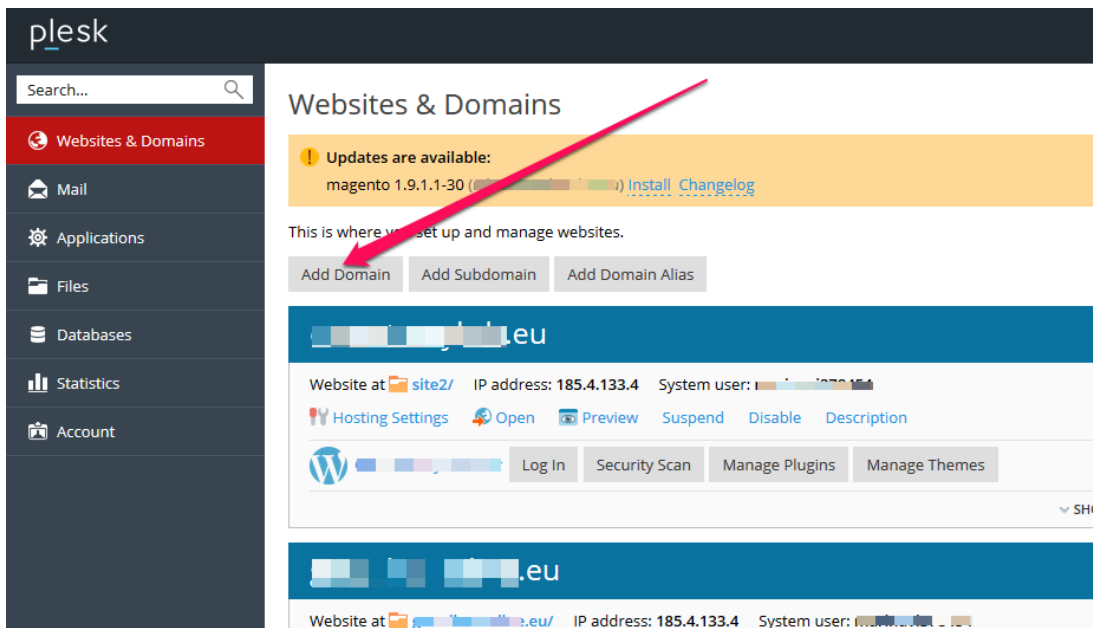

In case you want to create email accounts for your subdomains, you can add them to your plesk as a domain and then create your email accounts, following the instructions described below:

1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and then click on **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.

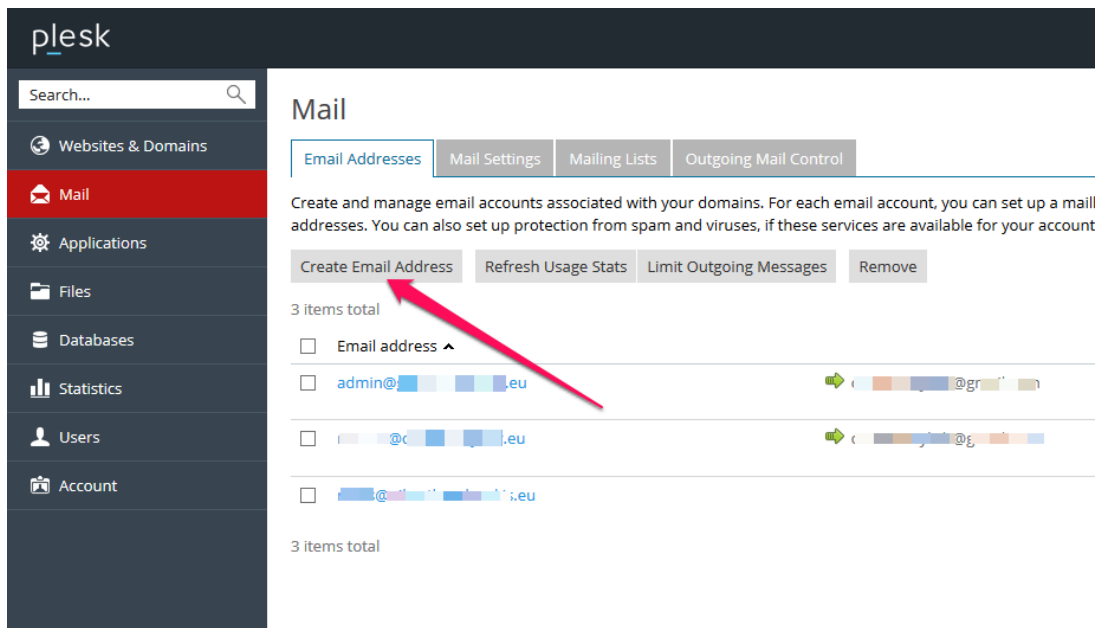


2. In the tab **Websites & Domains**, click on **Add domain**.



3. In the blank field (1) enter the desired subdomain, leave all the settings on default and click on (2) **OK**.

4. In the **Email** tab, click on **Create Email Address**.



5. On the next tab (**Create Email Address**) enter the following:

-The name of the email account (e.g. info) and select your subdomain from the drop down menu.

-The password that you want for your email account (it must contain symbols, letters and numbers) (2).

-Confirm the code by entering it a second time (3).

-Click on **OK** (4).
