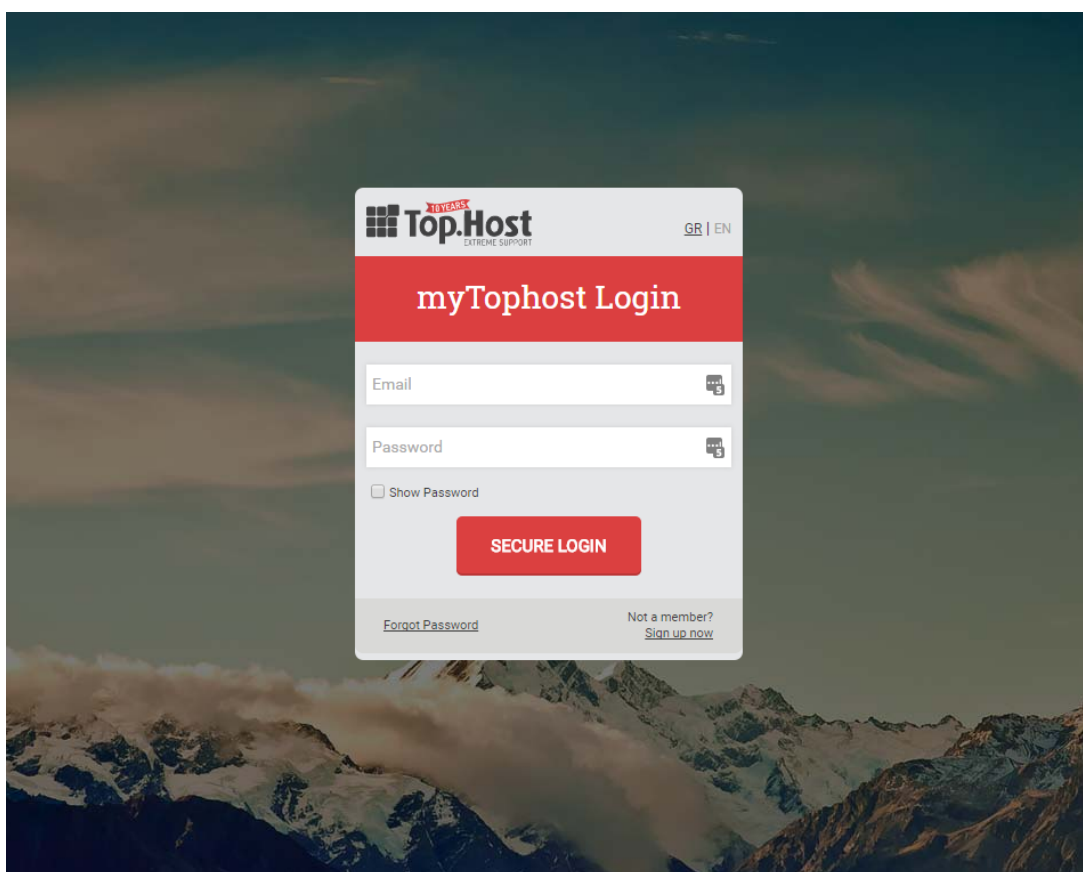


How can I connect a hosting plan to a domain name?

In order to connect the hosting plan that you purchased from Top.Host to your domain name, you will have to enter your domain to your web hosting plan and connect your hosting nameservers to your domain name. To do that, follow the steps below:

1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#).

2. In **My services** you can see that the hosting plan has automatically been connected to a temporary address. Click on the button **Manage** to proceed to the settings.

3. Click on **Administer Domain** in the Domain Name box.

Define the domain name to be used as the central domain of the Linux Economy Unlimited plan.

4. Insert the domain name that you wish to connect to your hosting plan and click on **Update**. With this procedure, the domain name is automatically added in Plesk.

Here you may administer the main domain for your **Linux Economy Unlimited** plan. To replace the domain already being used, insert the new domain in the according field and click the "Update" button.

Note:

After the connection, Top.Host's automated backup service will start taking backups for the new domain. Please, before proceeding, download any available backups locally on your computer [myTophost Backup manual](#).

5. In order to **complete the procedure** and for the domain name to load your site from the hosting plan, you need to **add the nameservers of the plan in your registrar**. There are 2 options:

No 1. If you have registered your domain name with Top.Host, the hosting plan will be automatically connected to the domain name, once you click on **Update** as shown in the previous step.

No 2. If you have registered your domain name with another registrar, you must insert the nameservers that we provided you to the **panel of your registrar**.

It might take up to 48 hours for the ISPs to be updated with the new nameservers.
