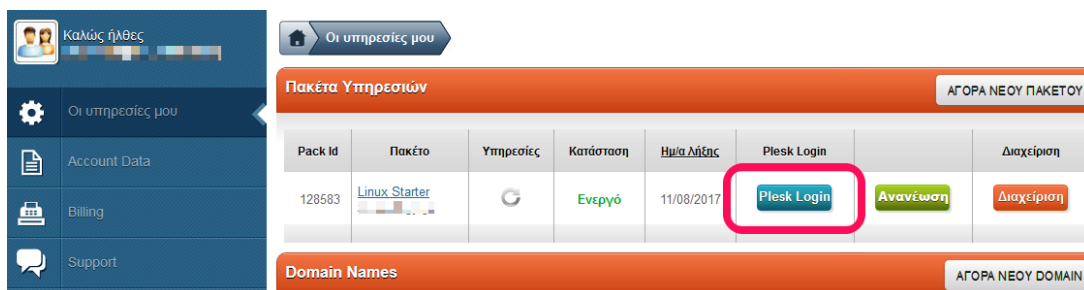
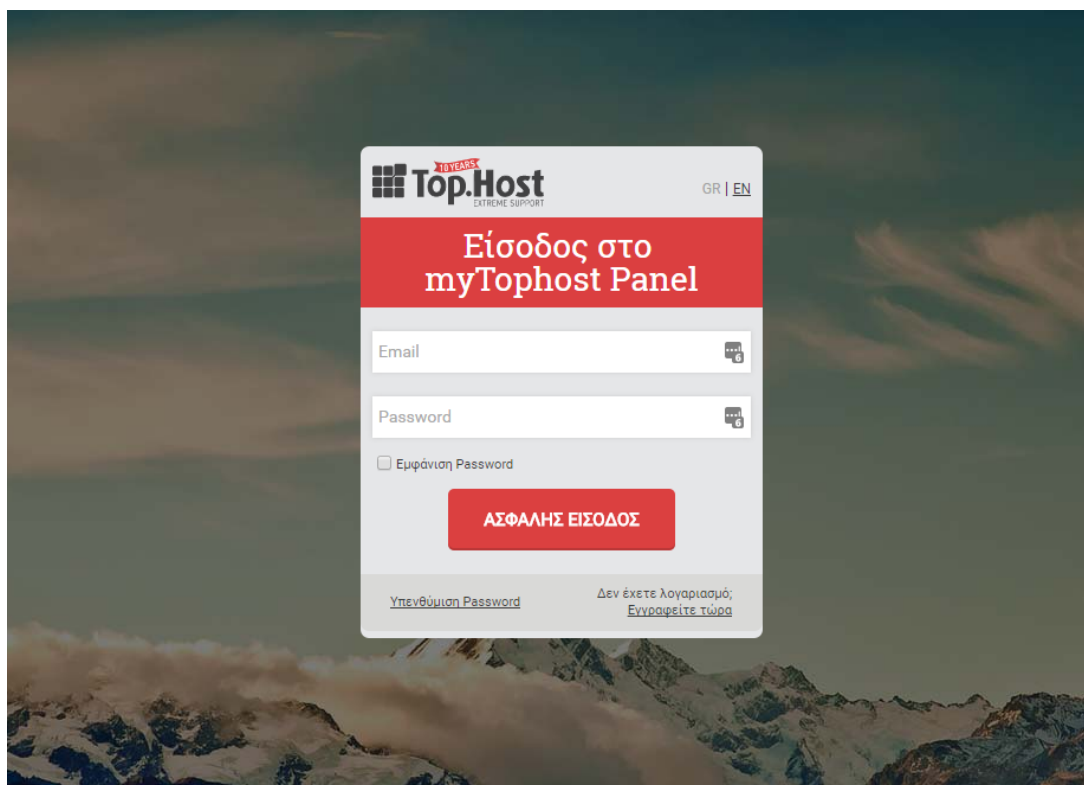


How can I change my DNS service from Master to Slave using Plesk?

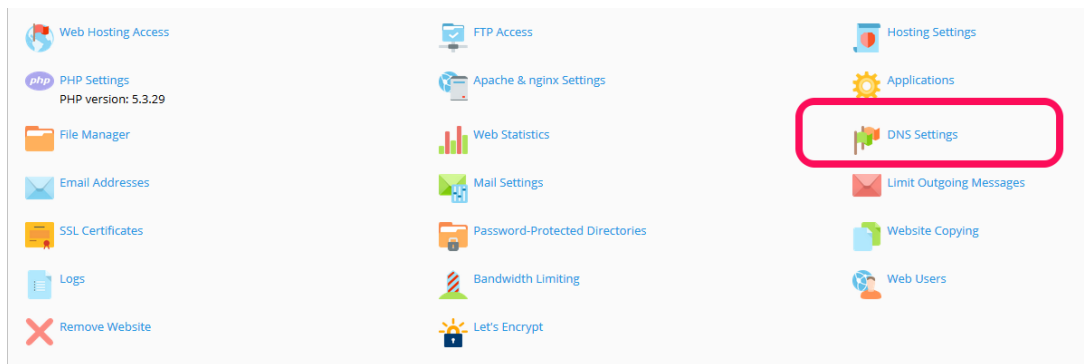

If you are hosting your sites through Plesk and you have an independent DNS server that acts as a main server (Master), you have the possibility to have Plesk act as a secondary server (Slave). In order to switch the two servers, follow the instructions described below:

1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and click on **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.



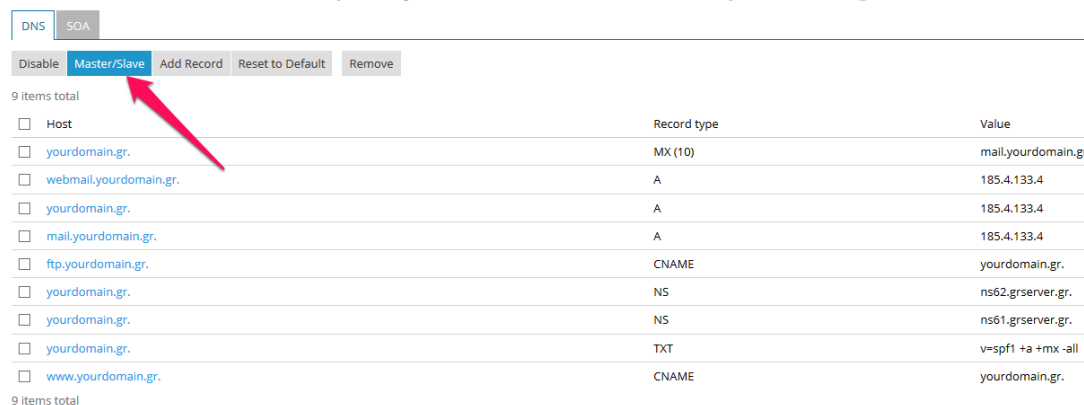
2. In the **Websites & Domains** tab, click on **DNS Settings**.



In order for your own server to become the main one:

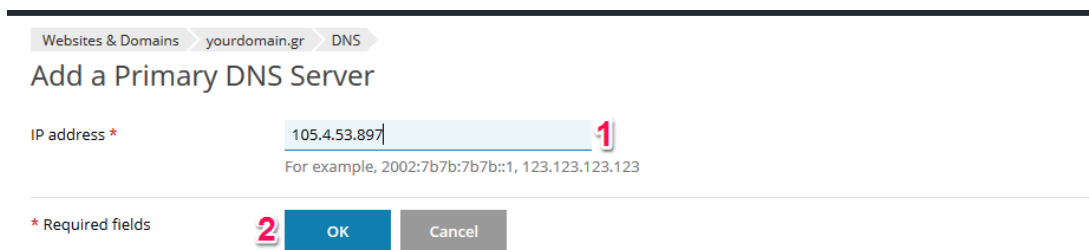
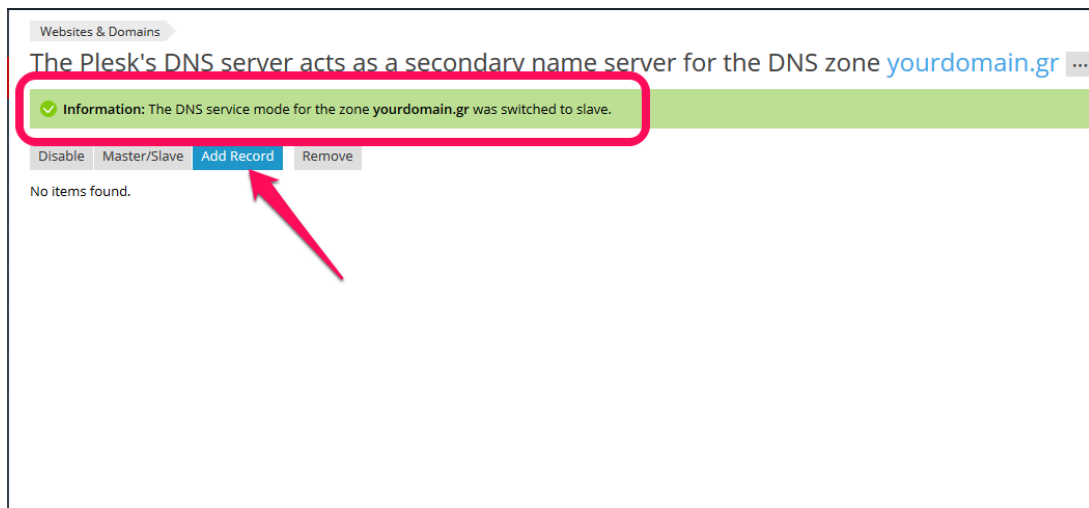
1. Click on **Master/Slave**.

The Plesk's DNS server acts as a primary name server for the DNS zone [yourdomain.gr](#) ...

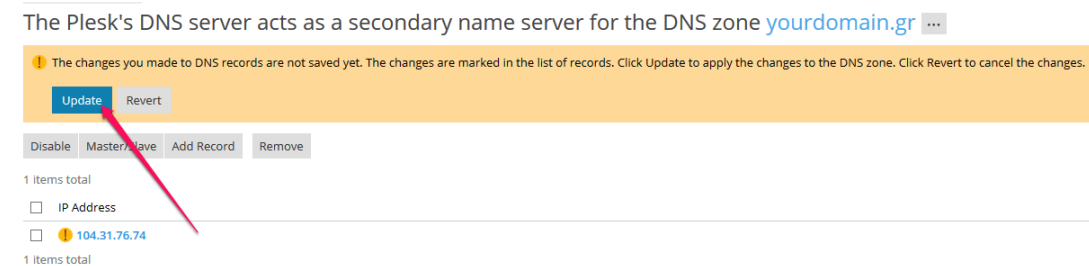


NOTE: Plesk will confirm that it has become the secondary server (slave).

2. Click on **Add Record** to enter the IP address that will act as the main server (Master).



3. Click on **Update**, in order for the change to be completed within a few hours.
