






In case you want to rename your main domain name to another one that already exists in Plesk, follow the instructions described below:

1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and click on **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.




2. Rename the domain name that already exists in Plesk to another one in **Hosting Settings** in the **Websites & Domains** tab.



In order to rename the domain name, follow the process described [here](#).

3. Log into myTophost Panel and rename the domain that you entered when purchasing your hosting plan, from **Manage** and more specifically in **Edit domain**.

5. In case you have subdomains, domain alias and email accounts, you will have to re-create them in Plesk. Follow the instructions described below:

7. Delete the domain that you renamed in the 2nd step. In order to delete the renamed domain through Plesk and more specifically by selecting **Remove website** from the
