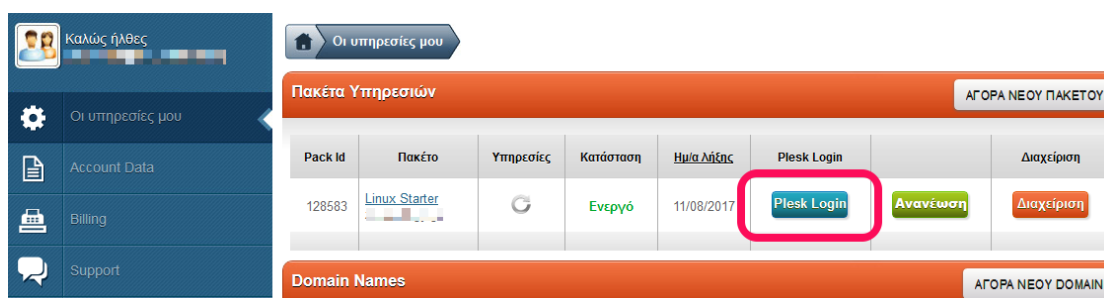
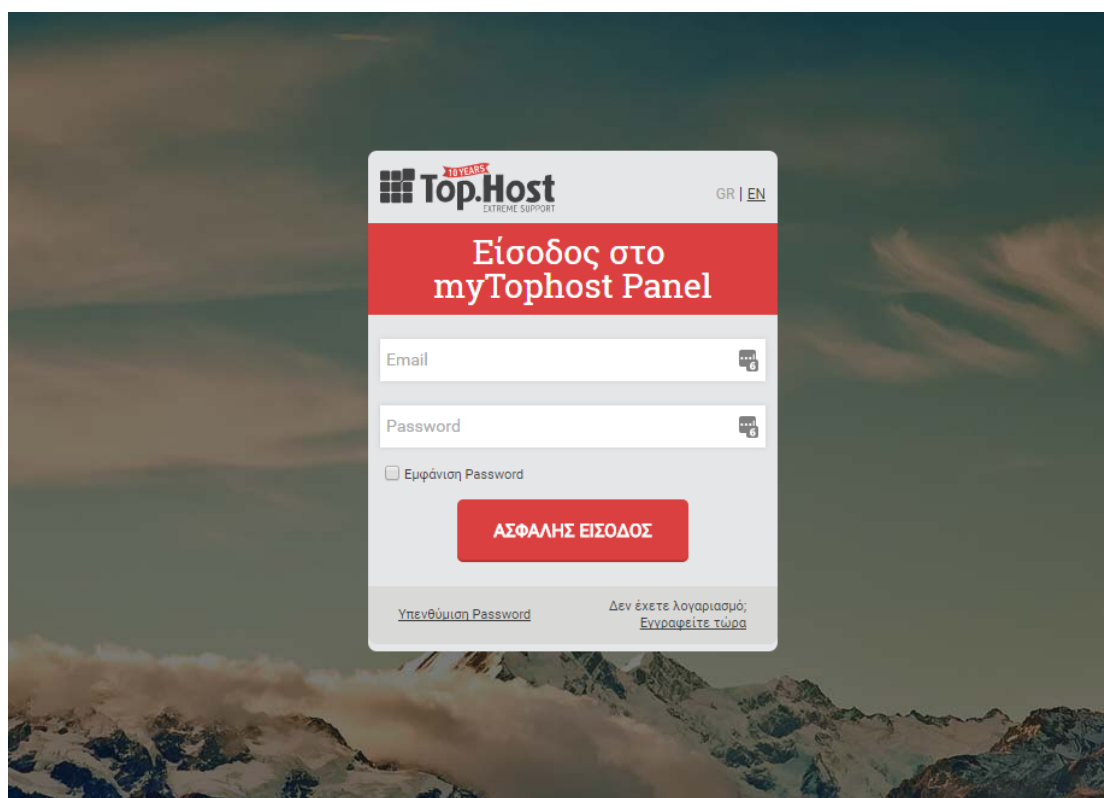


## How can I disable my website but keep my email service?

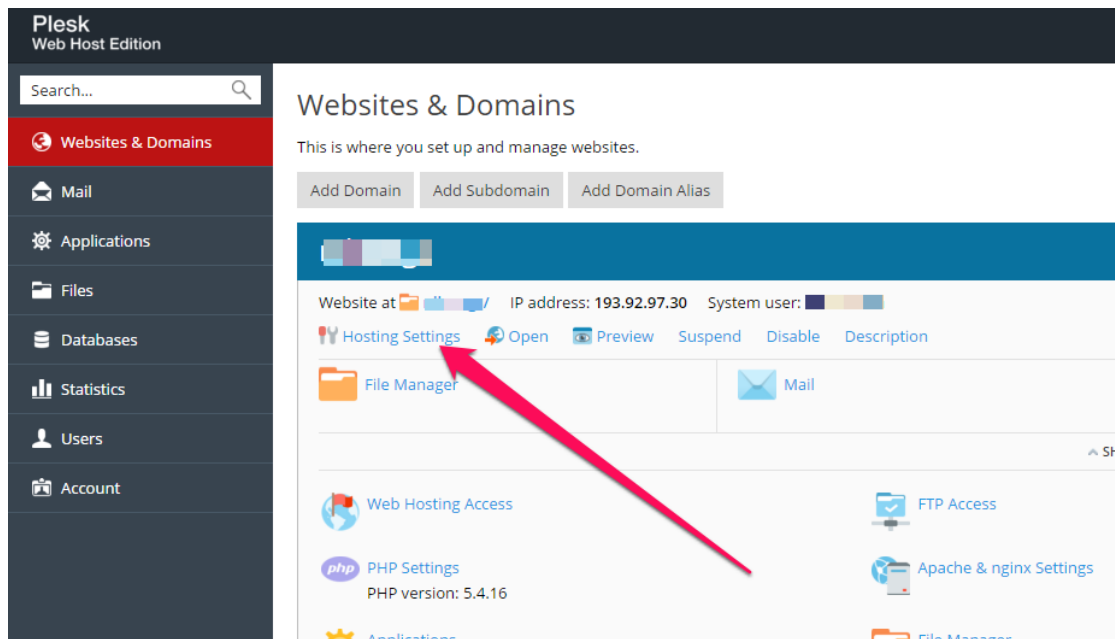

In case you want to disable the http service, but keep your Email, follow the instructions below:

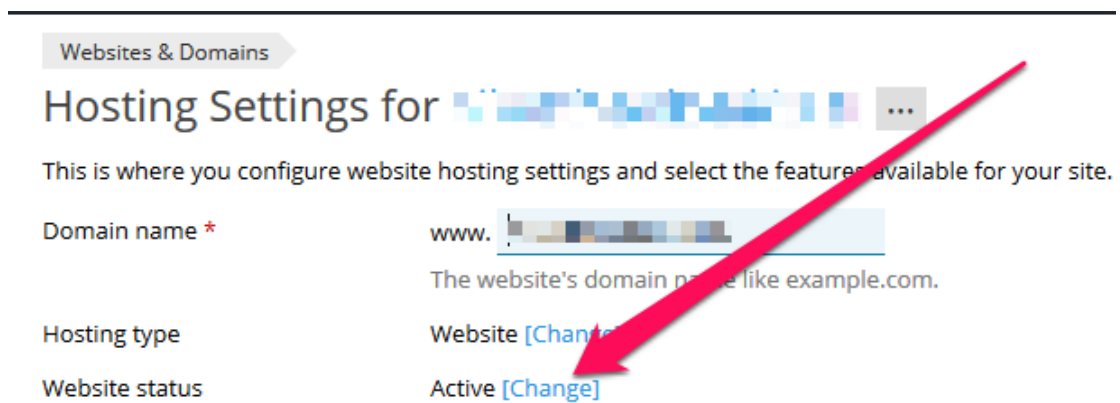
1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and click on **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.



2. In the **Websites & Domains** tab, click on **Hosting Settings**.



3. In **status**, click on **Change**, on the right-hand side of **Active**.



4. Select the **Suspended** option, click on **Apply** and **OK**. This way, your site will be inactive, but your email service will remain active.

## Change Website Status

### Website status

☐ Disabled (formerly known as Suspended)

The website will no longer be hosted on the server and will be unavailable except by FTP clients and File Manager. Visitors will see the web server's default page. The mail service will be unavailable.

☐ Suspended

Visitors will be redirected with the search engine-friendly 503 HTTP code to the custom error document page, although the website will remain hosted on the server. The mail service will remain available.

☒ Active

The website will operate as usual.
