


How can I enable my DNS service through Plesk?

When a domain is created in Plesk, the DNS records are automatically generated and you might not want them because you are using your own server. [If you disable the DNS service](#), Plesk gives you the possibility to re-activate it through the DNS Settings. In order to do that, follow the steps described below:

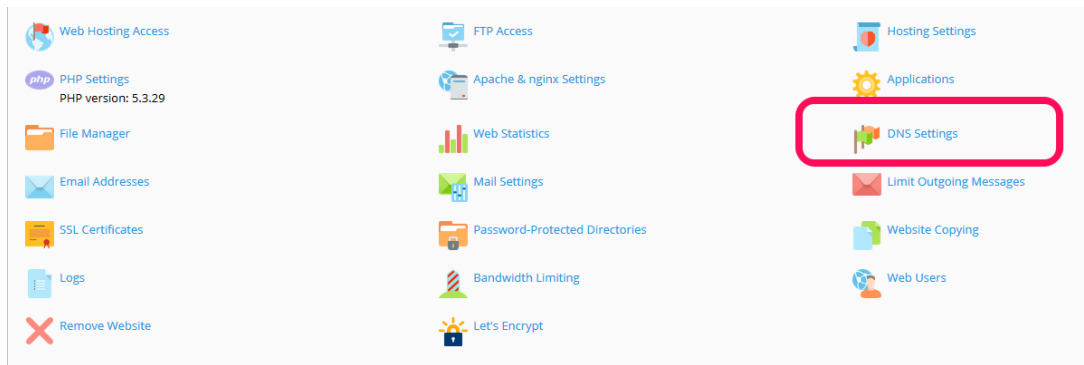
1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and click on **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.
