

Joomla redirecting from HTTP to HTTPS pages

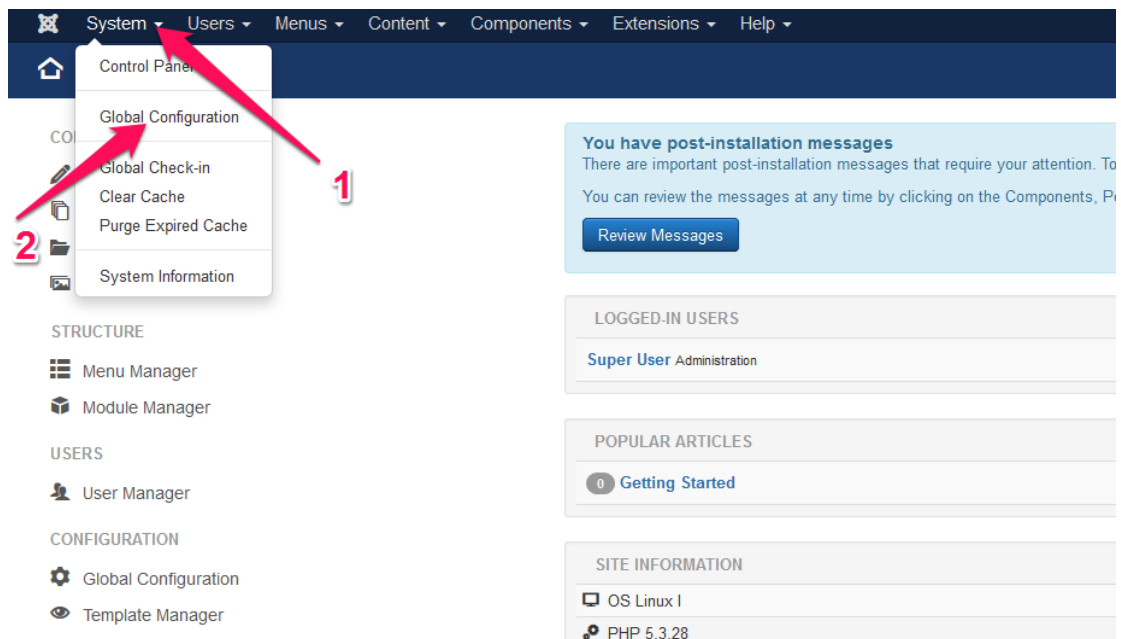

In case you have installed an SSL certificate on your site and the green lock doesn't appear on the top-left corner of your browser, then you must configure another setting in the Joomla administrative environment. In order to do this, follow the instructions described below:

1. Log into the Joomla administrative environment




2. Click on **System** (1) and then **Global Configuration** (2).



3. In **Force HTTPS** section, in the field **Server Settings** (1) from the drop down menu, select **Entire Site** (2)

and **Save** (3).

4. Once you have completed the previous tasks, download [SSL Redirect](#) and activate it through the Plugin Manager of your Joomla administrative environment.
