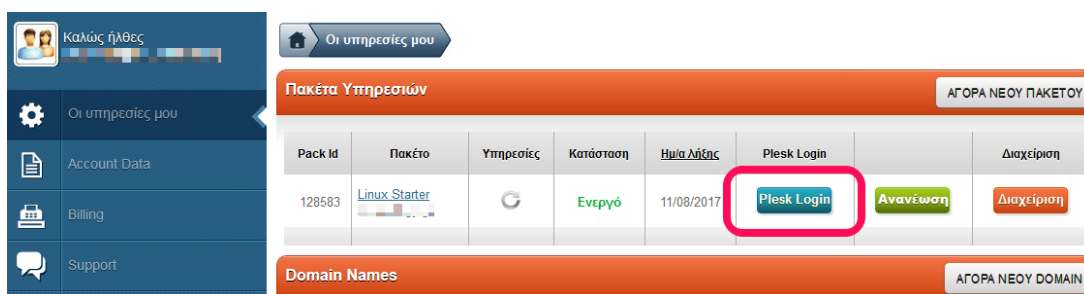
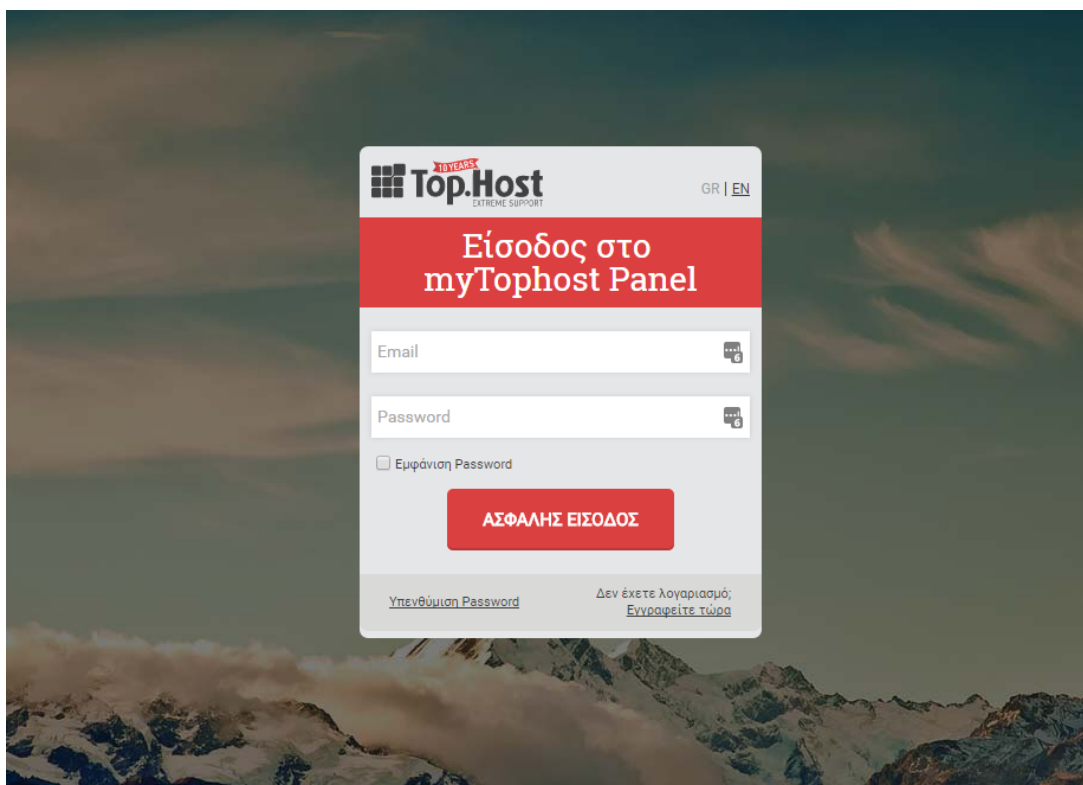


## How can I rename a domain name in Plesk Onyx?

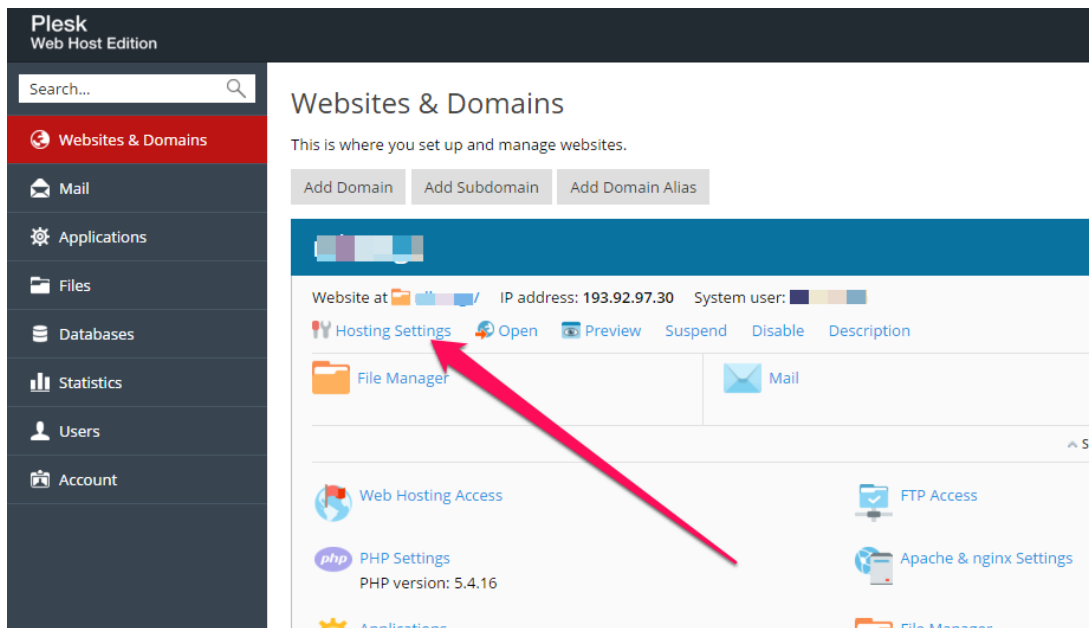

If you wish to **rename a domain name in Plesk**, take the following steps:

1. Log into [myTophost Panel](#) and then select **Plesk Login** in order to connect to the Plesk of the plan that you are interested in.



2. In the tab **Websites & Domains**, click on **Hosting Settings**.



3. In the field **Domain name**, enter the new domain name and click on **OK**.

This is where you configure website hosting settings and select the features available for your site.
