

How can I redirect http to https on a Windows plan?

If you have a **Windows** hosting plan and you wish to redirect it from http to https, create a **web.config** file and add the following command:

```
<?xml version="1.0" encoding="UTF-8"?>
<configuration>
  <system.webServer>
    <rewrite>
      <rules>
        <clear />
        <rule name="Redirect all requests to https" stopProcessing="true">
          <match url="(.*)" />
          <conditions logicalGrouping="MatchAll">
            <add input="{HTTPS}" pattern="off" ignoreCase="true" />
          </conditions>
          <action
            type="Redirect" url="https://{HTTP_HOST}{ REQUEST_URI}"
            redirectType="Permanent" appendQueryString="false" />
        </rule>
      </rules>
    </rewrite>
  </system.webServer>
</configuration>
```

Save it and upload it to your root folder.

Note: If there's already a web.config file on the server, open it with an editor, add the above command and save it.
