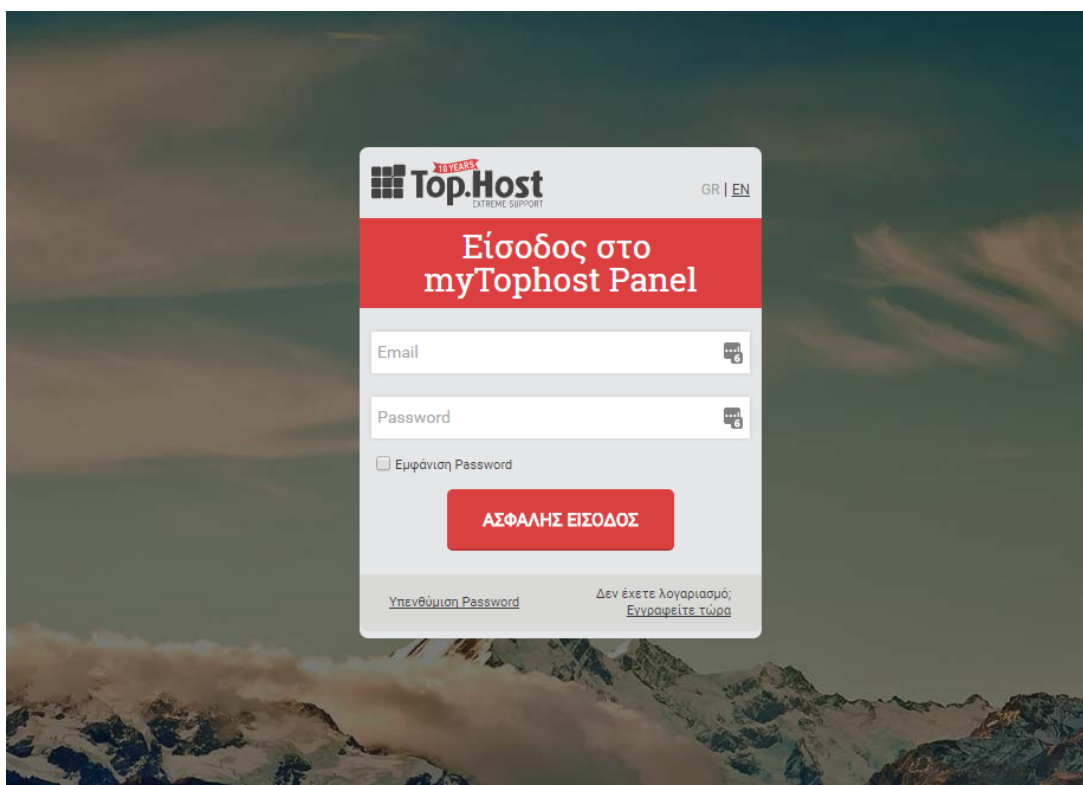


How can I disable the email service from Plesk Onyx?




